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# Crochet Flower Beanie

*Crochet this sweet flower beanie for your little one using single crochet and double crochet stitches. The flower, with its petal made with half double and treble crochet stitches, is the perfect accent for this adorable hat.*

## Stitches Used:

Chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet; half double and treble crochet stitches are used to make the flower

**Size:** Should fit a 12 month old baby

## Finished Measurements:

Flower Baby Beanie measures  
 18" (45.7 cm) circumference



## Supplies:

- 1 Skein (Color A) – Red Heart Super Saver, Petal Pink (or your choice of color)
- 1 Skein (Color B) – Red Heart Super Saver, Grey Heather (or your choice of color)
- H-8 (5mm) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle

## Gauge:

12 dc = 4" (10 cm) in beanie pattern; Rounds 1–3 = 3 1/2" (9 cm).

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Abbreviations:

A, B = Color A, Color B  
 ch = chain  
 dc = double crochet  
 sc = single crochet  
 sl st = slip stitch  
 st(s) = stitch(es)  
 hdc = half double crochet

tr = treble crochet  
 [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified  
 \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.

**Note:** to prevent any hazard for babies, omit the braids.

## Note:

1. Beanie is worked in joined rounds from the top down with right side facing throughout. Each round begins and ends at center back.
2. Flower is worked in rounds; earflaps are worked in turned rows.
3. Each flower petal is worked over 2 consecutive ch-3 spaces.
4. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops

on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## Tip:

For this method of crocheting in the round, you work in separate rounds, where you join the last stitch of each round to the first with a slip stitch and chain up to start the next round.

## Beanie Instructions

With A, ch 3; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 12 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 2, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 24 dc.

**Round 3:** Ch 2, dc in same st as join, dc in next st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 36 dc.

**Round 4:** Ch 2, dc in same st as join, dc in next 2 st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 48 dc.

**Round 5:** Ch 2, dc in same st as join, dc in next 7 st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next 7 st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 54 dc.

**Rounds 6–8:** Ch 2, dc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Change to B in last st of Round 8.

**Round 9:** Repeat Round 6; change to A.

**Rounds 10 and 11:** Repeat Round 6.

**Fasten off.**

## Right Earflap

With right side of last round facing, join A with slip st in 9th dc from center back.

**Row 1 (right side):** Ch 2, dc in next 6 dc, turn – 7 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, dc in next 5 dc; leave last st unworked, turn – 6 dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, dc in next 4 dc; leave last st unworked-5 dc.

Fasten off.

## Left Earflap

With right side of last round facing, skip next 24 dc from right earflap and join A with slip st in next dc.

**Rows 1–3:** Work same as right earflap.

## Border

With right side facing, join B with slip st in first dc at center back.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 1, sc in same st as join, sc evenly spaced all the way around lower edge of beanie, including edges of earflaps; join with slip st in first sc.

**Note:** When working in edges of earflaps, work 2 sc in end of each row on side edges and sc in each st across last row. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** With right side facing, join A in first sc at center back, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

## Braids (make 2)

Cut eighteen 28" (71 cm) lengths of A and two 15" (38 cm) lengths of B.

\*With 3 strands of A held together and leaving a 4" (10 cm) tail, tie a large, loose knot at one end. With right side facing, thread set of strands from wrong side through top of dc in Row 3 of earflap; repeat from \* to attach remaining sets of strands to remaining 2 sts. Braid sets of strands until 4" (10 cm) remains; wrap length of B around all 9 strands about 8 times and tie tightly. Trim ends to 3" (7.5 cm).

Repeat to attach braid to other earflap.

## FLOWER

Leaving a long tail for sewing, with A, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 1, 10 sc in ring; change to B; join with slip st in first sc – 10 sc.

**Round 2:** \*Ch 3, slip st in next sc; repeat from \* around-10 ch-3 sps.

**Round 3:** \*Ch 3, slip st in next ch-3 space; repeat from \* around.

**Round 4:** \*(Slip st, hdc, dc, 2 tr, ch 1) in next ch-3 space, (2 tr, dc, hdc, slip st) in next ch-3 space (petal made); repeat from \* around-5 petals. Fasten off.

## Finishing

Sew flower to side of hat over earflap or as desired.

Carefully untie knots at top of braids, ensuring that braids are not loosened from the beanie.

Weave in ends.

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
