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Crochet Flower Scarf

Scarves are a hot fashion accessory for spring and this lacy, scalloped-edge beauty will perk up any outfit. The edging is created with simple shell stitches and the flower accent adds a nice touch.

Designed by Red Heart Yarns

Stitches Used:

Chain stitch
 Single crochet
 Double crochet



Size:

Scarf measures 6 1/2" x 68 1/2" (16.5 x 174 cm).
 Flower measures 4 1/4" (11 cm) at widest point.

Supplies:

- 1 Skein (Color A) – Red Heart Super Saver, Lavendar (or your choice of color)
- 1 Skein (Color B) – Red Heart Super Saver, Monet (or your choice of color)
- Size K-10.5 (6.5mm) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Optional Accessory: 1 – Stitch Marker



GAUGE:

2 pattern repeats = 4" (10 cm) in scarf pattern; Rounds 1–3 = 3" (7.5 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Note: 1 pattern repeat consists of 1 shell and 1 single crochet.

Abbreviations:

A, B = Color A, Color B
Beg = Beginning
ch = chain
dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
tr = treble crochet

[] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified;
 * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated

Notes:

1. Scarf is worked in rounds. Read instructions carefully as some rounds are continuous (in a spiral) and worked with right side facing and others are turned.
2. You may find it helpful to place a marker at beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.
3. Flower is worked in turned rounds.
4. Beginning Shell = [Ch 2 (counts as first dc), 4dc] in indicated stitch.
 Shell = 5 dc in indicated stitch.

Tip:

Working into the back loop or bar of a stitch creates a horizontal bar or ridge.

Scarf Instructions

With A, ch 182.

Round 1 (right side): Working in back bars, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch to last ch, 2 sc in last ch – 364 sc.

Round 2: Sc in first sc, [skip next 2 sc, shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc] 30 times, shell in next sc, sc in next sc, [skip next 2 sc, shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc] 30 times, shell in next sc – 62 shells and 62 sc.

Round 3: Shell in first sc, [sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc] 30 times, skip first dc of next shell, sc in next dc, shell in center dc, sc in next dc, skip last dc, [shell in next sc, sc in center of next shell] 30 times, shell in next sc, skip first dc of last shell, sc in next dc, shell in center dc, sc in next dc, turn – 64 shells and 64 sc.

Round 4: Beg shell in first sc, *3 sc in center dc of next shell, [shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell] 31 times*, shell in next sc; repeat from * to * once; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2, turn – 64 shells and 68 sc.

Round 5 (right side): Beg shell in first sc, [sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc] 31 times, sc in next sc, shell in next sc; [sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc] 32 times, sc in next sc, shell in next sc, sc in center dc of last shell; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2, turn – 66 shells and 66 sc.

Round 6: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), 6 dc in first sc, sc in center dc of next shell, *7 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-66 7-dc groups and 66 sc. Fasten off

Flower

With B, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1 (wrong side): Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 10 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 15 sc.

Round 3: Ch 4, skip first 2 sc, slip st in next sc, *ch 4, skip next sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around, turn – 7 ch-4 sps.

Round 4: Ch 1, (sc, dc, 3 tr, dc, sc) in each ch-4 space; join with slip st in first sc – 49 sts. Fasten off.

Finishing

Sew flower to scarf as desired.

Weave in ends.

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
