

## Discover Textured Stitches Side-to-Side Scarf

### Supplies

- Bernat Super Value  
(100% Acrylic): 197 g/7 oz  
Shown in: #53531 Rouge
- Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook, or size to  
obtain gauge
- Yarn needle



INTERMEDIATE



Scarf measures approximately  
6 x 58"/15 x 147.5cm.

Tip

Try using two  
colors and alternating  
them every two rows  
for vertical stripes.

## Abbreviations

ch	chain
dc	double crochet
sk	skip
sl st	slip stitch
sp	space
st(s)	stitch(es)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

6"/15cm wide by 49"/124.5cm long.

## GAUGE

2 pattern repeats = 7"/18 cm;

6 rows in pattern = 4"/10 cm.

Note: One pattern repeat creates one "wave".

## SPECIAL TERMS

**Cl:** Cluster—Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**dc2tog:** Double crochet 2 stitches together—[Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**dc3tog:** Double crochet 3 stitches together—[Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**dc4tog:** Double crochet 4 stitches together—[Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

**dc7tog:** Double crochet 7 stitches together—[Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 7 times, yarn over and draw through all 8 loops on hook.

## NOTE

Take care when working decrease stitches (dc2tog, dc3tog, dc4tog, or dc7tog), read the instruction carefully. Sometimes a decrease is worked over a number of chains, sometimes over several chain-spaces (skipping the stitch between the chain-spaces), and sometimes over a number of stitches (the stitches could be a mix of dc stitches and ch stitches).

## SCARF

Ch 171. **Row 1:** Starting in 4th ch from hook, dc3tog over next 3 ch, [ch 1, dc in next ch] twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch, [ch 1, dc in next ch] twice, ch 1, \*dc7tog over next 7 ch, [ch 1, dc in next ch] twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch, [ch 1, dc in next ch] twice, ch 1; repeat from \* 12 times, dc4tog over last 4 ch, turn—14 "waves".

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk first ch-1 sp, Cl in next dc, ch 1, Cl in next dc, sk next ch-1 sp, 5 dc in next ch-1 sp, sk next ch-1 sp, Cl in next dc, ch 1, Cl in next dc, \*dc2tog over next 2 ch-1 sps, Cl in next dc, ch 1, Cl in next dc, sk next ch-1 sp, 5 dc in next ch-1 sp, sk next ch-1 sp, Cl in next dc, ch 1, Cl in next dc; repeat from \* across to turning ch, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, sk first dc, dc3tog over next 3 sts, [ch 1, dc in next dc] twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] twice, ch 1, \*dc7tog over next 7 sts, [ch 1, dc in next dc] twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] twice, ch 1; repeat from \* 12 times, dc4tog over last 4 sts, turn.

**Rows 4-9:** Repeat last 2 rows 3 times. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
