Classic Scarf for Fashion & Warmth

Stitches Used:

Knit stitch, garter stitch

Finished Measurements:

7½"; [19 cm] wide x 70"; [178 cm] long, excluding fringe.

Skill Level:



Basic / De base / Básico

Supplies:

3 balls - RED HEART® Soft Essentials™ - Seafoam
 1 Size US 10 1/2 (6.5mm) Knitting Needle
 1 Yarn needle



Special terms/Techniques to be taught:

Bind off, Cast on and slip knot, Garter stitch, Gauge, Weave in ends, Adding fringe, Reading a Pattern.

Gauge:

13 stitches = 4"; [10 cm]; 26 rows = 4"; [10 cm] in Garter stitch (knit every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge

Abbreviations:

None

Instructions: Scarf

Cast on 24 stitches.

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit across row.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit across row.

Continue to work in Garter st (knit every row) until Scarf measures 70"; [178 cm] or desired length.

Bind off loosely.

Fringe:

Cut 52 strands of yarn, each 13"; [33 cm] long. Hold 2 strands together and fold in half. Pull folded loop through a stitch along one short end of Scarf. Pull the ends through the loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach 13 fringes evenly spaced along short end. Repeat to attach remaining 13 fringes along opposite short end. Trim ends of fringe evenly.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.
